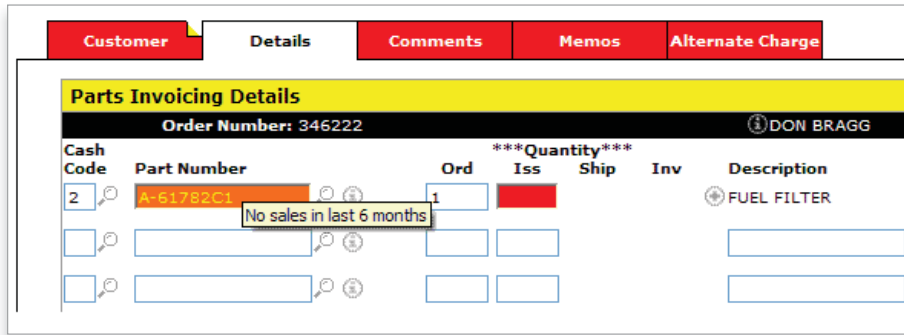
## New parts features available in R6V07

Here are a few of the recent enhancements to the Parts module in the current release R6V07.

### Parts Highlighting

This feature allows a set of custom highlighting rules to be applied to the parts invoicing system. Rules for highlighting can be based on fields such as OFC code, return code and critical code. Also, pre-set rules are available to choose from. Some examples are: having a duplicate part on the invoice, a part that is already on a stock order, or a part that is available in another location. A description of the rule will show when you mouse over the part that is highlighted, and the colors are customizable.



### Option to force user to select lost sale reason when removing part off invoice

There is a new security switch in system 823 Product Support - Parts Invoicing that will force the user to record a lost sale in order to remove a part from an invoice.

### Ability to move parts from stock order to ST/TS order

When you are maintaining a stock order, the system will check to see if the part number is also available on a Special Terms Program. If it is, a new "ST" icon will appear. By clicking the icon, the system will show the program(s) that the part is on and any changeable ST/TS orders for those program(s).

## ATTENTION CANADIAN PAYROLL USERS

Before your first check run for 2010, you will need to apply the 2010 tax changes. The 2010 Canadian payroll rates will be available as a PPU and can be requested from PFW Support. The PPU must be requested after your last payroll check run of 2009 and before your first payroll check run of 2010.

*NOTE: The federal exemption amounts for 2010 have increased, so this will need to be updated accordingly through Employee Maintenance.*

## ATTENTION U.S. PAYROLL USERS

Before your first check run for 2010, you will need to update your FICA, MEDICARE and USFED tables. You will still be able to perform check runs in January if the new tables aren't loaded—you have a one-month grace period—but you will not be able to complete your first check run in February until the 2010 tables are loaded.

*NOTE: If your state tax rate has changed, you must also update these values in the USSTATE table. These values should be confirmed with your local tax office.*

## IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ALL JOHN DEERE DEALERS

All John Deere dealers should have already received communications from John Deere on the replacement of the JDWIN Warranty Interface by the **John Deere WINXML Warranty Interface**. John Deere will be utilizing an SAP Warranty product for the handling of warranty processes and that is the main reason for this new interface.

The PFW R6V07 release (IntelliDealer only) is the only release where this new interface will be supported. All PFW clients should upgrade to R6V07 to ensure they are ready once this product has gone through the proper product testing process.

According to timelines coordinated with John Deere, the suggested beta dealer testing for the **John Deere WINXML Warranty Interface** will begin in March and the estimated general release will be in May 2010.

We have also heard that in the future, John Deere will be discontinuing the **JDWIN** interface.
